How to set up Facebook Business Manager for your Brand

Create a Business Manager account, Facebook page, and Facebook Ad Account for your business, to start managing all your Facebook Assets and sharing them with your employees securely.

Goal: To create a Business Manager account and Facebook Ad Account for your business.

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Ideal Outcome: You will have a Business Manager account ready to manage all your Facebook Assets and share them with your employees securely. You will set up a Facebook and Instagram page if you do not already have one, and then link them to the Business Manager. You will have created your Facebook Ad Account and set your Payment Method.

Why this is important: Facebook's Business Manager allows you to easily manage multiple pages and ad accounts, while also being able to safely assign roles to your employees and agency team.

🧐 Where this is done In Facebook's Business Manager.

When this is done: The first time you are creating a Business Manager account.

Who does this: The business owner or the person responsible for paid advertising on his behalf. Pote: If you are a FRANCHISEE, check with your franchisor team prior to engaging in these steps, as they may have some of these pieces in place already.

A Prerequisites or requirements: You will need a personal Facebook account.



Create a Business Manager Account

01► Go to <u>https://business.facebook.com</u> in your browser. Log in first to see if you already have a business account. If not, it will prompt you to create a new one.

02 Click on "Create an Account" at the bottom.

Create a Facebook Page on Business Manager

01 If you **already have a Facebook page**, you now should claim it via Facebook Business Manager (FBM).

- Head to the FBM "Settings" by clicking on the gear icon on the left-hand menu of the FBM home page (or go directly to this url: https://business.facebook.com/settings/)
- Click on Business Settings and another page will appear. Under the "Accounts" tab on the left side of the screen, hit the "Pages" button, which shows all of the Pages under your supervision.
- Click on the "Add" button that appears on the screen and then the "Add a Page" selection.
- Enter the name of the Facebook Page or its URL and then click the "Add Page" button to finalize the claim.
- Once you claim the appropriate Pages, you can manage them yourself or <u>delegate others</u> to do it within FBM.
- 02> If you **<u>do not</u> already have a Facebook page**, create one following these steps.
 - Go to Business settings.
 - Below Accounts, click **Pages**.
 - Click **+ Add**.
 - Click Create a New Page.
 - Choose a category for your page.
 - Enter a Page name and fill in any requested fields. You can make further edits later.



- Click Create Page.
- Click **Assign Partners** and select **Business ID.** Paste in this ID: 10153479623514564. Toggle all of the options to "On."

03 Customize your Facebook page with a profile photo, links to your website, business hours, etc. <u>Instructions here</u>.

Create an Instagram Account and Link to FBM

01 Follow these steps to set up an Instagram account

02> Don't forget to link Instagram to Facebook Business Manager!

- □ Go to Business settings.
- Click Accounts.
- Click Instagram accounts.
- □ Click the blue **Add** button.
- Click Connect your Instagram account
- □ Enter your Instagram username and password. **Note:** We may send you a security code to the email or phone number associated with the account to verify your identity.
- You'll have the option to select the ad accounts and pages you'd like to assign on the next screen. Assign your business Facebook page, and if you have an ad account, you can assign that as well. Click **Finish.** You can also click the **X** to skip this step.
- Click Assign Partners and select Business ID. Paste in this ID: 10153479623514564. Toggle all of the options to "On."

01 On your <u>Business Manager Home page</u>, click on "Ad accounts" under "Accounts":
